Educator Salary Schedules

- > The salary schedules are determined annually by legislation.
- Step and Lane" schedules where by
 - ➤ the "Steps" are years of experience 0 to 25+
 - the "Lanes" are education (Bachelors, Masters and National Board Certification (NBPTS)
- Movement to the next step increase is not automatic and must be authorized by the General Assembly.
- > All schedules are derived from the Bachelor "A" schedule.
- Additional compensation may apply including local salary supplement and performance bonus.




History of Teacher Compensation

Teacher Monthly Salary Schedule Bachelors Level 2009 and 2019




Educator Years of Experience

Average Teacher Compensation Estimate for 2018-19

- In 2018, State base salary + local supplement made up 98% of the average compensation
 - State Base Salary is estimated to increase approx. 5.5%
 - Local Supplement to increase by approx. 5.5%
