PROGRAM INFO

Founded in 1973, the Governor's Page Program gives high school students from all over North Carolina the opportunity to come to Raleigh for a week of hands-on participation in their state government. Pages grow in four areas: history, civics, service, and professional development.

Participants receive a \$200 stipend to compensate for any costs associated with the program, and participation in the program is an excused absence from school.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligible participants are high school students or recent high school graduates in good academic standing.

- 1) Fill out the application.
- 2) Have two people fill out the recommendation form.
- 3) Application is complete!
