## PARDON FOR

## ARTIMUS RASHAUD QUICK

**WHEREAS**, Artimus Rashaud Quick, at the February 14, 2008, Term of Buncombe County District Court, pled guilty to Driving While Impaired, Docket Number 07CR058428, and was sentenced to a term of one hundred twenty (120) days in the North Carolina Department of Correction, suspended for twelve (12) months with probation for twelve (12) months, and;

WHEREAS, Artimus Rashaud Quick, now seeks a pardon from the Governor, in light of the circumstances surrounding his crime, his subsequent record and current need; and

**WHEREAS**, Artimus Rashaud Quick's record since this conviction has been one of responsible civic behavior and community service.

**NOW**, **THEREFORE**, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, in consideration of the above factors, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents PARDON the said Artimus Rashaud Quick, it being full and unconditional Pardon. This Pardon shall not apply to any other offenses.
