COMMUTATION ORDER

FOR

JOSEPH EDWIN BROMFIELD

WHEREAS, JOSEPH EDWIN BROMFIELD, at the August 1990 Term of Cumberland County Superior Court, was convicted of First Degree Murder, Docket Number 89CRS17204, and by judgment of said Court was sentenced to life in prison in the custody of the North Carolina Department of Correction; and was convicted of First Degree Murder, Docket Number 89CRS17205, and was sentenced to a consecutive sentence of life in prison; and

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to me that this case is one fit for a Commutation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents **COMMUTE** his sentence to make him parole eligible subject to the condition that if he is placed on parole, he shall not violate any conditions of his parole or have his parole revoked for any reason.

If the Governor, or his successor, finds that JOSEPH EDWIN BROMFIELD has violated any condition herein provided, then the Governor or his successor may, in his or her discretion, revoke or modify the Commutation granted this day.

This Commutation Order shall not extend to any other offenses.

This Commutation Order is effective this the 31st day of December 2024.
