PARDON OF FORGIVENESS ORDER

FOR

JOHN WILLIAM CAMPBELL

WHEREAS, John William Campbell, at the May 1984 Term of Wake County Superior Court, pled guilty to three (3) counts of Sale and Delivery of Cocaine, Docket Numbers 84CRS6948, 84CRS8781, and 84CRS10404, and was sentenced to three (3) years in the custody of the North Carolina Department of Correction, which was suspended for three (3) years and Campbell was placed on probation for three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, John William Campbell now seeks forgiveness from the Governor, in light of the circumstances surrounding his crime, his subsequent record and current need; and

WHEREAS, John William Campbell's record since these convictions has been one of responsible civic behavior and community service.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, in consideration of the above factors, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State, do by these presents PARDON the said John William Campbell, it being a Pardon of Forgiveness. This Pardon shall not apply to any other offenses.
