REWARD PROCLAMATION

As Governor of North Carolina, the following information has been furnished to me:

Amy Wells Bridgeman, age 42 when reported missing, was last seen on June 24, 2013, at a residence in the South Weldon area in Halifax County. Ms. Bridgeman left the residence, leaving her purse behind. Her husband received a text from her on June 28, 2013, and she has not been seen or heard from since. On June 29, 2013, Ms. Bridgeman was reported missing by her husband.

To preserve law and order the person or persons who committed such an infamous crime must be brought to justice.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, under and by virtue of the authority in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 15-53.1, do hereby offer a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the disappearance of Amy Wells Bridgeman.

The payment of this reward, or any portion thereof, is conditional upon the information being furnished as a direct result of the issuance of this proclamation. The total reward paid to all persons in this case shall not exceed \$5,000.

The reward offered herein does not extend to any law enforcement officer of the State or any political subdivision thereof.

Anyone having information about this case should contact the Halifax County Sheriff's Office, Halifax County Crimestoppers or the State Bureau of Investigation.
