REWARD PROCLAMATION

As Governor of North Carolina, the following information has been furnished to me:

On the evening of February 12, 2016, unknown individuals shot into an occupied home on Forrester Street in Durham. Dorothy Holloway, age 72, was shot, causing significant injuries resulting in the amputation of one leg. Officers do not believe that Ms. Holloway was the intended victim in this shooting.

To preserve law and order the person or persons who committed such an infamous crime must be brought to justice.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Roy Cooper, Governor of the State of North Carolina, under and by virtue of the authority in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 15-53.1, do hereby offer a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the drive-by shooting of Dorothy Holloway.

The payment of this reward, or any portion thereof, is conditional upon the information being furnished as a direct result of the issuance of this proclamation. The total reward paid to all persons in this case shall not exceed \$5,000.

The reward offered herein does not extend to any law enforcement officer of the State or any political subdivision thereof.

Anyone having information about this case should contact the Durham County Sheriff's Criminal Investigation Division, Durham Crimestoppers or the State Bureau of Investigation.
