

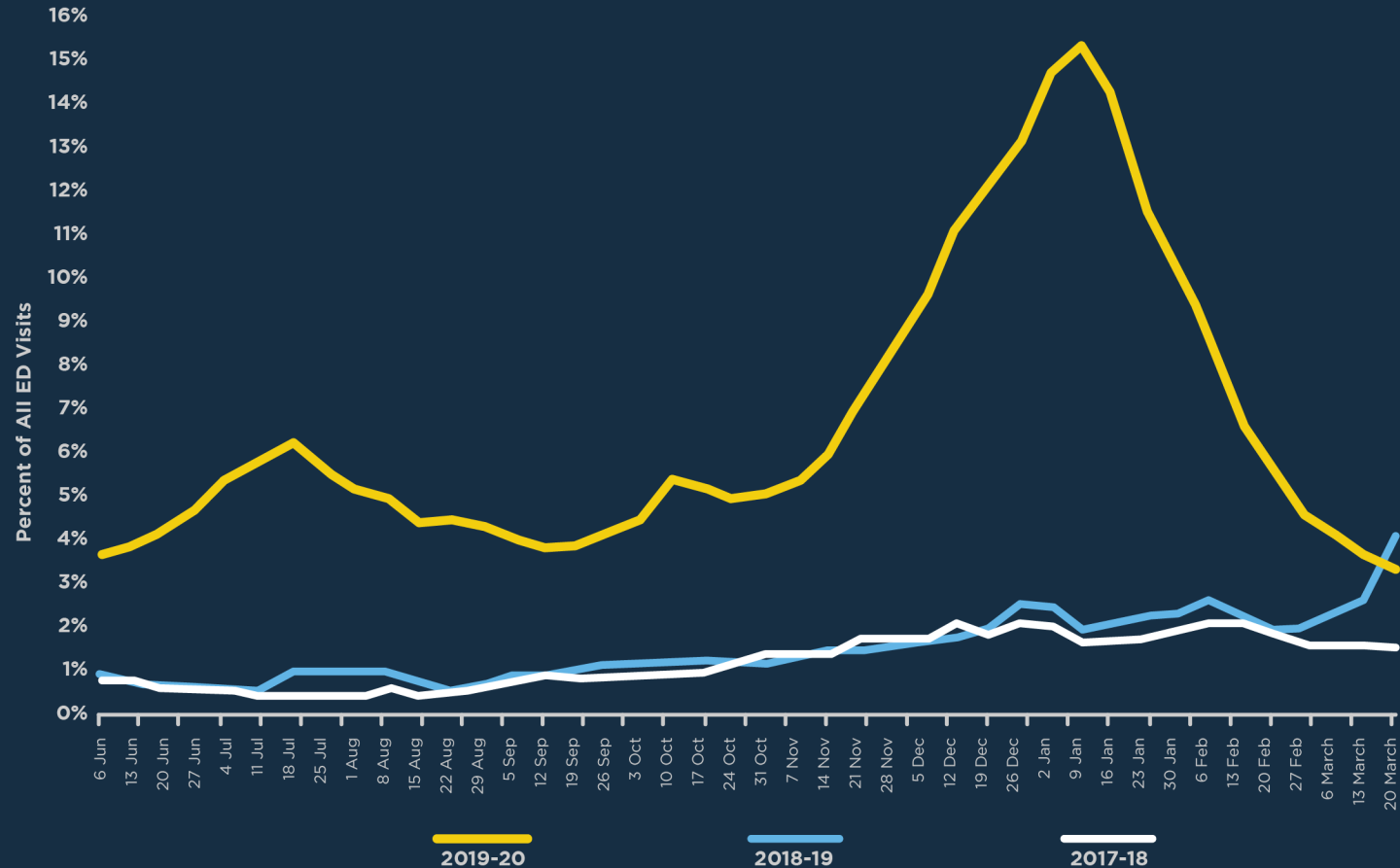

Trajectory of COVID-like Syndromic Cases

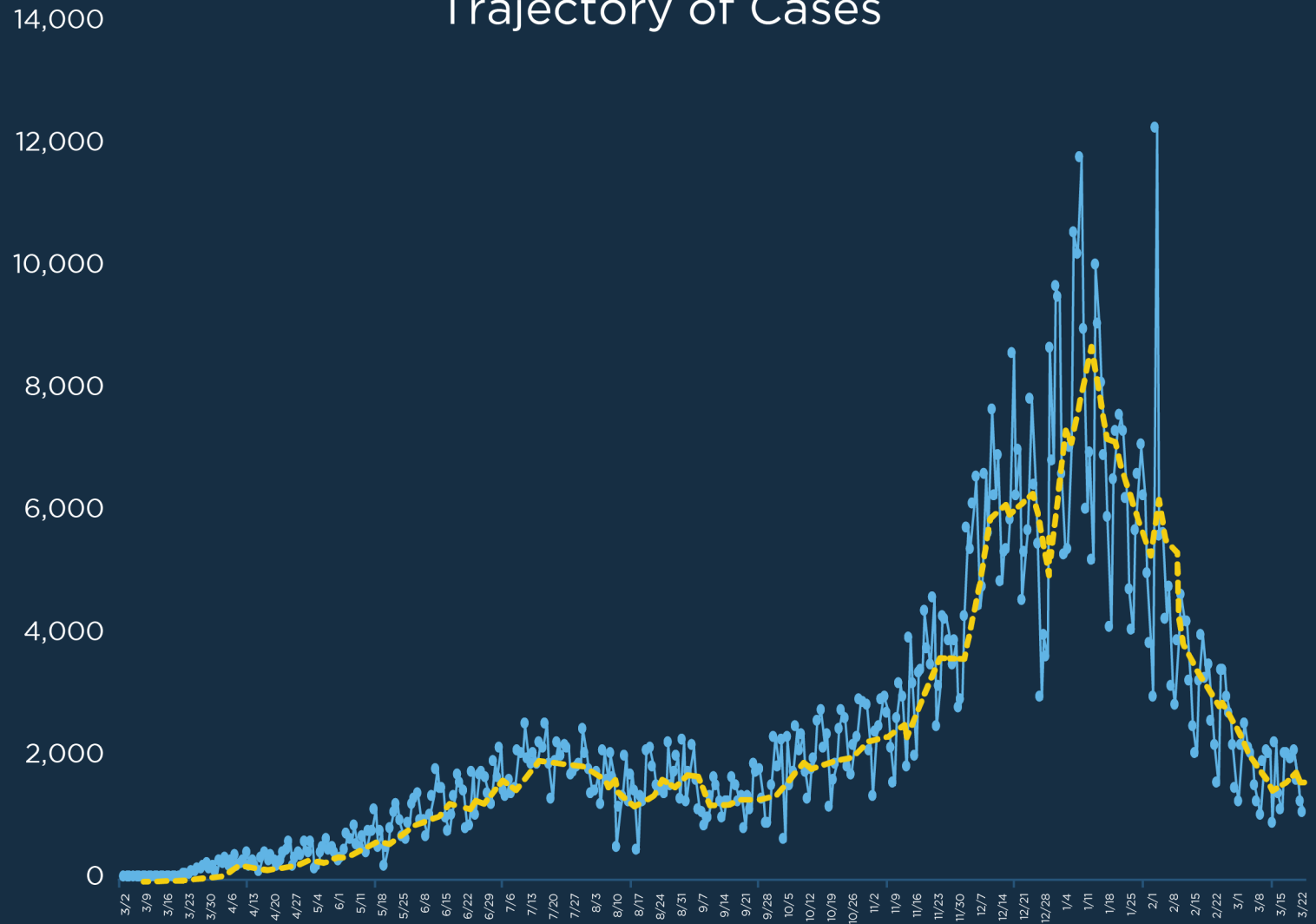

The percent of visits to the Emergency Department for COVID-like illness is **decreasing**.

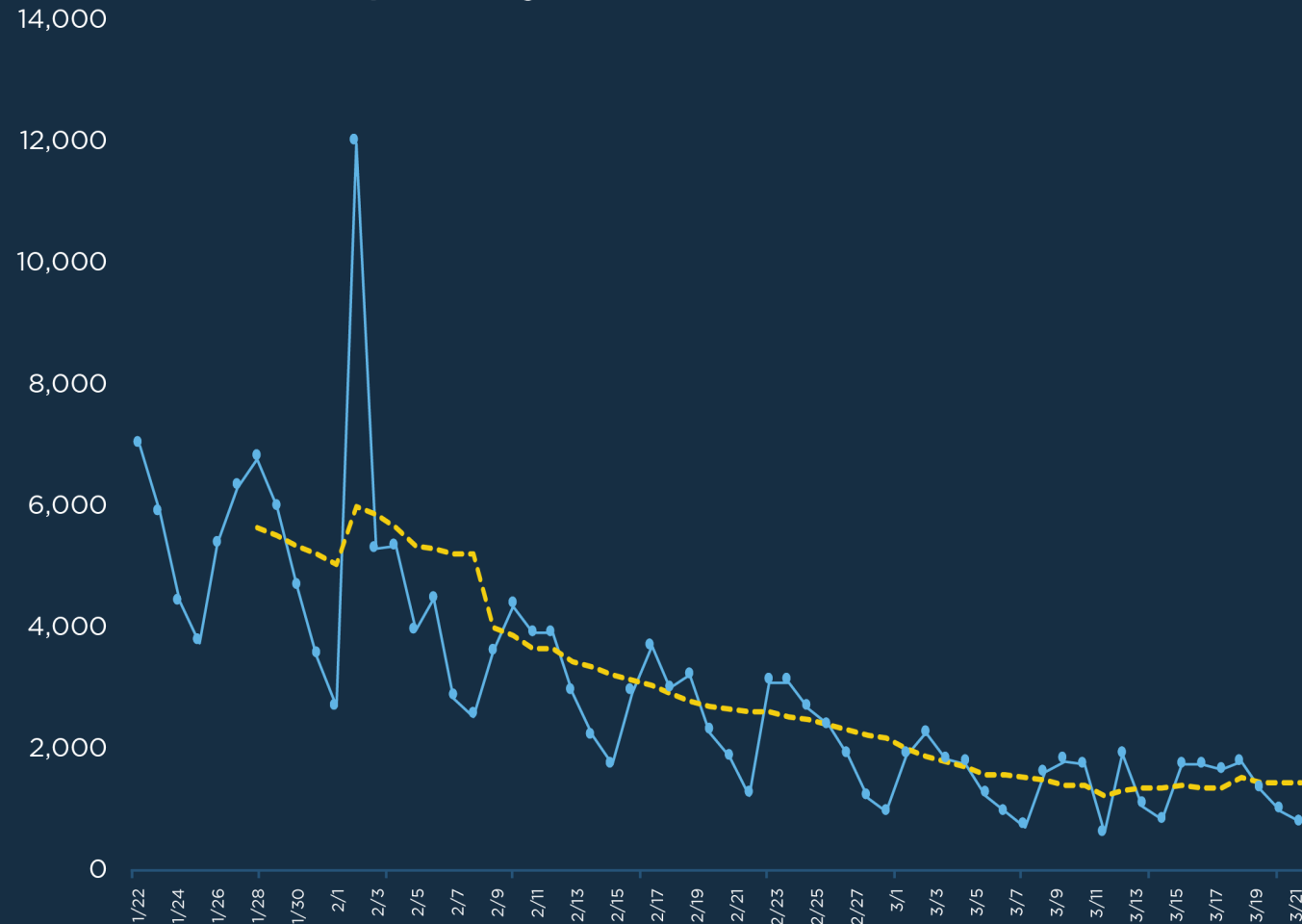

Trajectory of Cases from 1/22

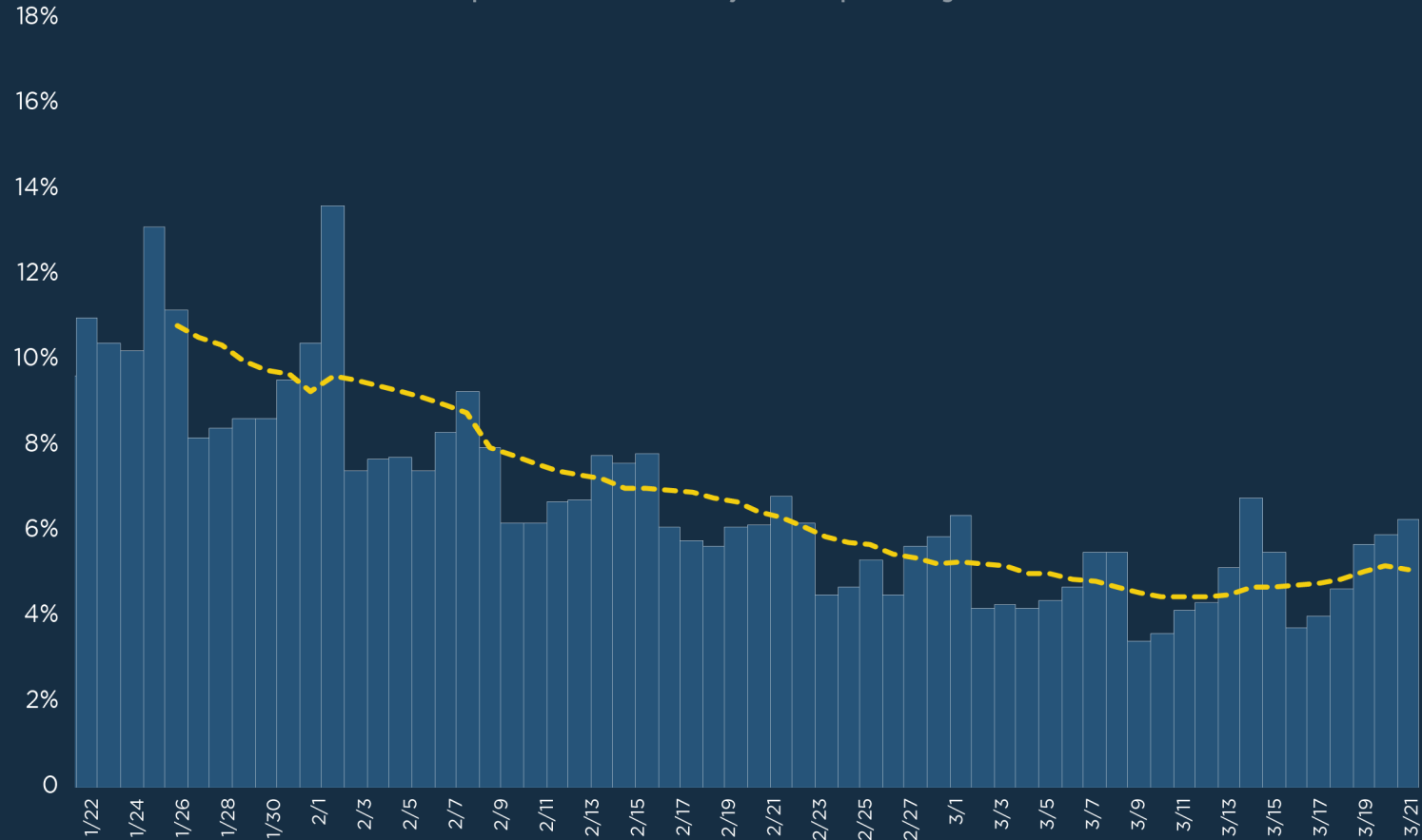


From 1/22, new cases in North Carolina are **leveling**.

Percent positive for SARS-CoV-2 by date of report among ELR labs

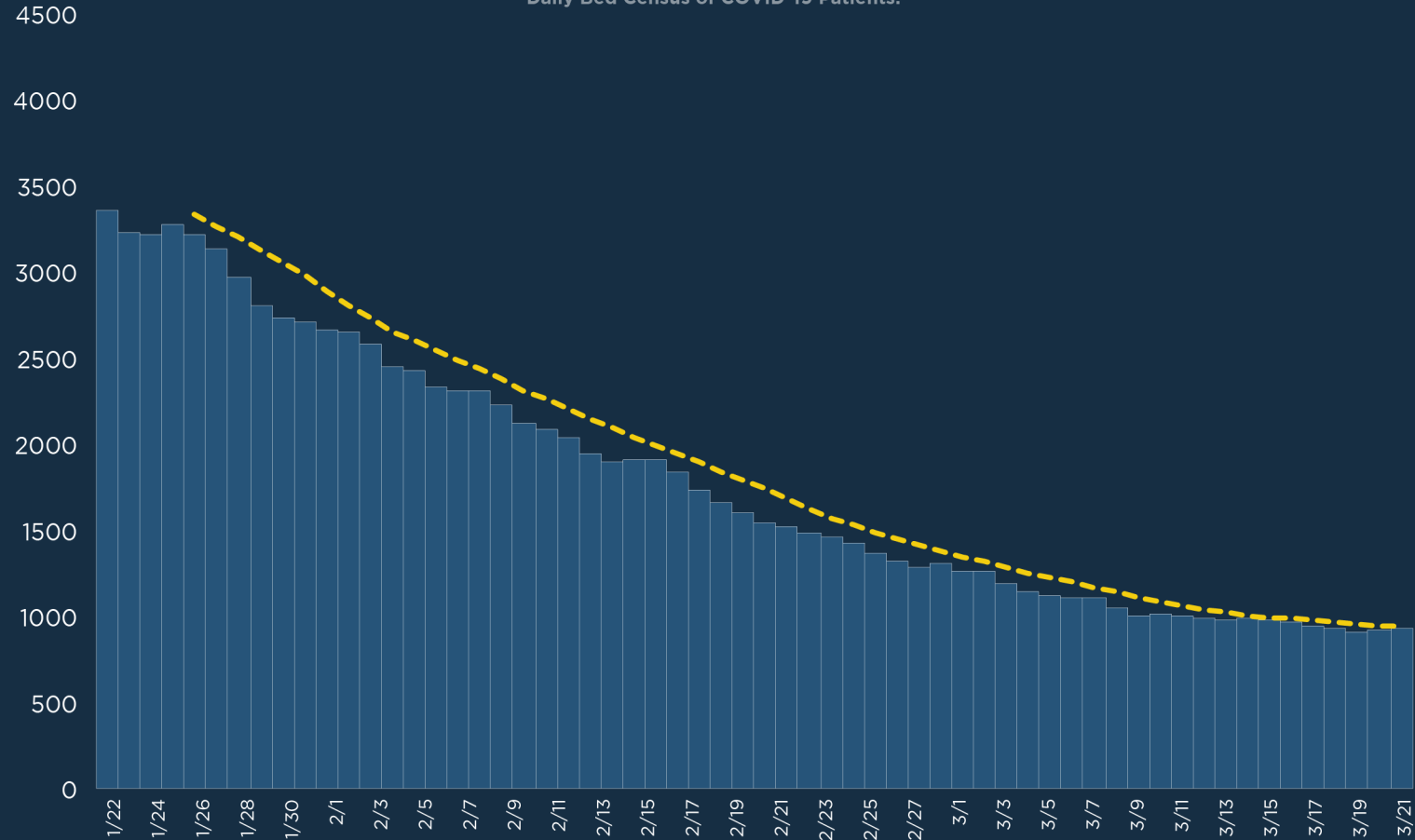


The trajectory of positive tests as a percentage of total tests is **leveling**.

Executive Order 204 goes into effect

Friday, March 26, 2021 at 5pm:

Mask Mandate will stay in place.

Executive Order 204 (3/26/21)

Businesses that can operate up to 100% occupancy with safety protocols in place:

- Museums
- Aquariums
- Retail Businesses and Shops
- Barbers/Salons/Personal Care

Executive Order 204 (3/26/21)

Businesses that can operate up to 75% capacity indoors and 100% outdoors with safety protocols in place:

- Restaurants
- Breweries and Wineries
- Amusement Parks
- Gyms and Pools

Executive Order 204 (3/26/21)

Some business settings to increase capacity up to 50% with safety protocols in place:

- Conference Centers
- Bars
- Sports Arenas
- Other Live Performance Venues

Effective **Friday, March 26 at 5pm:**

Restriction on late-night sale of alcohol for on-site consumption is lifted.

Effective **Friday, March 26 at 5pm:**

Mass gathering limit, increased to
50 indoors and 100 outdoors.
