EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 87

NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 67

WHEREAS, the undersigned issued Executive Order No. 51 on 7 September 2018 ("Executive Order 51"), which declares a State of Emergency to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of North Carolina residents and visitors affected by Hurricane Florence (the "Hurricane"); and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 51 invokes the North Carolina Emergency Management Act (the "Act") and authorizes the Governor to exercise the powers and duties set forth therein to direct and aid in the response to, recovery from, and mitigation against emergencies; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina's response to and recovery from the Hurricane has been impeded by the loss and/or destruction of North Carolinians' birth certificates and other vital records; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, pursuant to the Act and with the concurrence of the Council of State, issued Executive Order No. 67 on 23 October 2018 ("Executive Order 67") to suspend the collection of certain fees for North Carolina vital records; and

WHEREAS, the suspension of the collection of certain vital records fees was necessary to help rehabilitate North Carolinians and restore property impacted by the Hurricane; and

WHEREAS, suspension of the collection of these fees is no longer necessary.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and the laws of the State of North Carolina, **IT IS ORDERED**:

Section 1.

Executive Order 67 is hereby rescinded.
