EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 88

NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 86

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 86, Declaration of a State of Emergency and Temporary Suspension of Motor Vehicle Regulations to Ensure Restoration of Utility Services and the Transportation of Essentials, was issued on 13 January 2019 ("Exec. Order 86"), and declared a state of emergency for the entire State of North Carolina due to the widespread power outages from a winter storm; and

WHEREAS, Exec. Order 86 also waived the maximum hours of service for drivers transporting supplies and equipment for utility restoration and essentials in commerce, and, with the concurrence of the Council of State, temporarily suspended size and weight restrictions on vehicles used for utility restoration and carrying essentials on the interstate and intrastate highways due to the impacts from the winter storm.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and the laws of the State of North Carolina, **IT IS ORDERED**:

Section 1.

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 166A-19.20(c), the declared state of emergency and the transportation waivers in Exec. Order 86 are hereby terminated immediately.
