WHEREAS, the North Carolina Division of Child Development and Early Education works to promote and inspire high quality early childhood experiences that can provide a foundation of learning and success for our children; and

WHEREAS, teachers and others who work with or on behalf of children birth through age eight make a lasting impact on the lives of the young people of North Carolina and deserve thanks and recognition; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Association for the Education of Young Children, along with the North Carolina Early Childhood Advisory Council, the North Carolina Education Cabinet, the Department of Health and Human Services, the Division of Child Development and Early Education, the Department of Public Instruction, and the North Carolina Partnership for Children, join together in recognizing and supporting the people, organizations, and programs committed to providing high quality, early childhood education and services to the families of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim April, 2018, as the "MONTH OF THE YOUNG CHILD" and April 16 – 20, 2018, as the "WEEK OF THE YOUNG CHILD" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
