A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the success of the independent bookstores of our state relies heavily on community support and patronage; and

WHEREAS, there is a national movement to shop at independent bookstores on the final Saturday of April each year; and

WHEREAS, events held on this Saturday and throughout the year at bookstores across North Carolina support the creative endeavors of diverse authors, writers, artists, illustrators, poets, and many other individuals and groups in our communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim April 28, 2018, as "INDEPENDENT BOOKSTORE DAY" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
