A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, window film helps to create safe, secure environments for homes and vehicles, public buildings, and retail establishments; and

WHEREAS, window film manufacturers in the United States significantly impact our national economy and employment; their products offer benefits that contribute to energy savings, improve public health, and reduce carbon footprints; and

WHEREAS, window film is an increasingly effective solution to the ultraviolet rays that can cause skin cancer, offering substantial indoor protection by blocking up to 99.9 percent of UVA radiation; protection against solar glare and skin damage is especially important to the health of commercial drivers who risk long exposure to the sun; and

WHEREAS, the window film industry contributes to a strong economy in North Carolina by providing consumers and businesses with a cost-effective means of saving energy, and by creating job opportunities in communities throughout our state; and

WHEREAS, the window film industry is committed to educating the public on the benefits of window film through their nonprofit trade association, the International Window Film Association; and

WHEREAS, National Window Film Day is an opportunity to acknowledge the men and women in the industry who manufacture, distribute, and install window film, and to educate the public about the industry's contributions to our society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2018, as "NATIONAL WINDOW FILM DAY" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
