WHEREAS, returning home to Elm Street Park, North State was greeted by an enthusiastic crowd – including members of the 1998 Tar Heel All-Stars, the first Greenville team to make it to the Little League World Series; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 North State All-Stars have furthered Greenville's storied baseball tradition, and paved the way for generations of future Greenville Little Leaguers; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina is proud to congratulate Greenville Little League, and recognize the accomplishments of this North State All-Star team, wishing them continued success in all their future endeavors;
