A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, essential to the criminal justice system, community corrections professionals uphold the law with dignity while recognizing the right of the public to be safe-guarded from criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, community corrections professionals are responsible for supervising adult and juvenile offenders in the community; and

WHEREAS, working in partnership with community agencies and groups, these trained professionals provide services and referrals for offenders; and

WHEREAS, community corrections professionals promote prevention, intervention, and advocacy; provide services, support, and protection for victims; and advocate community and restorative justice; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Public Safety employs approximately 2,050 certified probation/parole officers who supervise approximately 100,000 offenders in North Carolina communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim July 16 – 22, 2017, as "PROBATION, PAROLE, AND COMMUNITY SUPERVISION OFFICERS' WEEK" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
