A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, parks and recreation programs are an integral part of communities throughout this country, including in the State of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, our parks and recreation are vitally important to establishing and maintaining the quality of life in our communities, ensuring the health of all citizens, and contributing to the economic and environmental well-being of our region; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation programs build healthy, active communities that aid in the prevention of chronic disease, provide therapeutic recreation services for those who are mentally or physically disabled, and also improve the mental and emotional health of all citizens; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation programs impact a community's economy by increasing property values, expanding the local tax base, encouraging tourism, attracting and retaining businesses, and reducing crime; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation areas are fundamental to the environmental well-being of our community; and

WHEREAS, parks and natural recreation areas improve water quality, protect groundwater, prevent flooding, improve the quality of the air we breathe, provide vegetative buffers to development, and produce habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, our parks and natural recreation areas ensure the ecological beauty of our community and provide a place for children and adults to connect with nature and enjoy outdoor activities; and

WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives has designated July as Parks and Recreation Month; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina recognizes the benefits derived from parks and recreation resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim July, 2017, as "PARK AND RECREATION MONTH" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
