A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, watermelons are enjoyed by millions of consumers every day as a versatile and nutritious commodity; and

WHEREAS, the industry also employs many of our state's citizens and provides supplemental income for a number of rural families who farm on a part-time basis; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina is one of the top producers of watermelons in the nation, and the industry is of great importance to the state's economy; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina watermelon industry generates an estimated \$21.4 million in farm income, according to the 2016 agricultural statistics from the North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina grew nearly 180 million pounds of watermelons on 6,600 acres in 2016; and

WHEREAS, the watermelon industry is yet another part of the total diversification of agriculture in our state; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina urges citizens to support the industry throughout Watermelon Month and during every watermelon season;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim July, 2017, as "WATERMELON MONTH" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
