WHEREAS, Dumas's humanitarian efforts also include: supporting the Make-A-Wish Foundation with "Pennies from Heaven" on his radio show, volunteering for disaster relief with the American Red Cross, and providing a platform for North Carolinians to raise awareness for causes important to our communities; and

WHEREAS, after 25 years on the air, Dumas remains one of the top-ranked radio DJs in the country, and continues to entertain listeners every weekday morning on G105 WDCG iHeart Radio on "Bob and the Showgram" from 6:00 - 10:00am; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina commends Bob Dumas for 25 years of success in radio, 10 years of outstanding work through Bob's Buddies, and ongoing contributions to the citizens and communities of our state and nation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim July 6, 2017, as a day "IN RECOGNITION OF BOB DUMAS" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
