WHEREAS, the Marine Corps League is a great asset to the State and we are grateful for the selfless acts of charity and service they provide to Raleigh and throughout North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina encourages all citizens to join in commending the members of the Marine Corps League for the differences they make in all our communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim June 18 – 24, 2017, as "MARINE CORPS LEAGUE WEEK" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
