WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina and the Statewide Safety and Health Steering Committee encourage all state employees to commit to safety and to work together to eliminate hazards and prevent injuries;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim June, 2018, as "**SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
