WHEREAS, Communities In Schools student support specialists are relationship builders, who see unique potential in each student and make lasting connections with students who may not otherwise have this resource; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina joins in recognizing Communities In Schools' services to students throughout our state, and encourages eligible students and adults to enroll in a program or volunteer as a tutor or mentor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim June 28, 2018, as "**COMMUNITIES IN SCHOOLS DAY**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
