A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) Karate has been a longtime supporter of the state of North Carolina, hosting their nationals for multiple years in Raleigh and Winston-Salem; and

WHEREAS, after Greater Raleigh Sports Commission hosted their National Championships event in 2015, AAU Karate elected to return in 2017, and is planning to include Raleigh as a rotational city; and

WHEREAS, AAU Karate National Statistics include 1,500 athletes, 350 coaches, 50 officials, and over 100 clubs across the United States; and

WHEREAS, AAU Karate in North Carolina reflects the mission statement of the AAU: to offer amateur sports programs through a volunteer base for all people to have the physical, mental, and moral development of amateur athletes; and to promote good sportsmanship and good citizenship;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim June 29, 2017, as "AMATEUR ATHLETIC UNION KARATE DAY" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
