A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Youth Art Month is an annual celebration supported through The Council for Art Education to emphasize the value of visual art education in a student's overall success, and to encourage support for quality art programs in our schools; and

WHEREAS, experience in the visual arts fosters and enhances valuable skills – such as imagination, creative expression, effective collaboration, innovation, resourcefulness and adaptability – that are not the focus of other subjects in the curriculum; and

WHEREAS, Youth Art Month directs attention to the value of a visual art education and promotes commitment to the arts from students, educators, community organizations, and individuals; and

WHEREAS, the 2017 – 2018 theme for Youth Art Month is Building Community Through Art; and

WHEREAS, in support of Youth Art Month, each state coordinates a contest in which students design a flag based on the annual theme; the winning designs are made into flags, which are displayed and recognized at the National Art Education Association Convention; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina commends youth art students and educators throughout our state, and encourages our communities to support art programs in our schools;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim March, 2018, as "YOUTH ART MONTH" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
