WHEREAS, the public services provided and maintained by state employees have contributed to making North Carolina one of the fastest growing states in the nation; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina expresses gratitude this week, and throughout the year, to state employees who demonstrate leadership, courage, and compassion in serving our state, communities, families, and individuals;
