WHEREAS, lung cancer is the number one cancer killer of women and men in the United States; and

WHEREAS, public support for lung cancer research funding will result in better treatment and early detection methods critical to diminishing the fatality rate of patients; and

WHEREAS, advocacy and increased awareness will promote screenings and early detection for people with lung cancer that will ultimately save lives; and

WHEREAS, LUNG FORCE is a national initiative led by the American Lung Association to fight against lung cancer; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina encourages all residents to learn more about lung cancer, risk factors, and screening options;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim the second full week in May, 2017, as "**WOMEN'S LUNG HEALTH WEEK**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
