A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, travel and tourism are vital to North Carolina's economic prosperity, business productivity, and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, travel and tourism to and within North Carolina provide significant economic benefits for the state, generating \$22.9 billion in direct visitor spending in 2016; and

WHEREAS, the travel and tourism industry is among the largest private sector employers in North Carolina, supporting more than 218,000 jobs; and

WHEREAS, travel and tourism support and benefit more than 45,000 businesses in North Carolina that directly serve travelers; and

WHEREAS, visitor spending directly generated tax revenues of \$3.6 billion for federal, state, and local governments, funds used to support essential services and programs for our citizens; and

WHEREAS, travel and tourism impact all 100 counties in North Carolina and provide a savings of \$497 to each household in state and local taxes; and

WHEREAS, leisure travel spurs countless benefits, including health and wellness, creativity, cultural awareness, education, happiness, productivity, and relationships;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 8 – 14, 2017, as "**TRAVEL AND TOURISM WEEK**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
