A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, our values of caring for neighbors, welcoming strangers, and comforting the troubled are rooted in our rural tradition of humility, hospitality, and service;

WHEREAS, the continued success of the State of North Carolina is dependent upon the connected economies, strong relationships, and mutual goodwill of its rural and urban communities; and

WHEREAS, the designation of Rural Day will recognize the commitment of rural residents to their communities, reemphasize our state's appreciation of rural North Carolina, and reaffirm our collective support to improving the quality of life across all communities in North Carolina;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 9, 2017, as "RURAL DAY" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
