**WHEREAS**, due to the generosity of grateful citizens who have participated in their golfing events, Tee It Up for the Troops has donated approximately \$7 million to more than 300 veterans support organizations since 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, Tee It Up for the Troops salutes all North Carolinians who have answered the call to duty; on November 7, 2017, a Tee It Up for the Troops golf event will be held at MacGregor Downs Country Club in Raleigh to support and thank our service members and veterans; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of North Carolina recognizes Tee it up for the Troops Day to support programs that enhance the lives of those and their families who serve and have served on our behalf;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim November 7, 2017, as **"TEE IT UP FOR THE TROOPS DAY"** in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
