A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the purpose of the North Carolina Military Veterans Hall of Fame, a nonprofit organization organized under the laws of the State of North Carolina, is to highlight and emphasize the honor brought to our state and nation by the sacrifice of our veterans and their families; and

WHEREAS, those instrumental in founding and maintaining the North Carolina Military Veterans Hall of Fame are deserving of our highest recognition and appreciation; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina commends the North Carolina Military Veterans Hall of Fame, and honors today our veterans, living and dead, for their limitless courage and sacrifice in service to our country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 14, 2017, as "NORTH CAROLINA MILITARY VETERANS HALL OF FAME DAY" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
