A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, established nationally in 1988 by Public Law 100-402, Hispanic Heritage Month honors the culture, history, and achievements of Hispanics, acknowledging especially Hispanic people in the United States for their many contributions to American society; and

WHEREAS, also in September, Brazil, Chile, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, and Nicaragua celebrate the anniversaries of their independence; and

WHEREAS, in North Carolina, we take this time each year to recognize the social, cultural, and economic impact Hispanics and Latinos have made on our way of life; and

WHEREAS, the Hispanic community is part of the fabric of North Carolina, enriching our schools and education system; bolstering the economy as business owners, employers, and entrepreneurs; and contributing to the overall growth and progress of our state; and

WHEREAS, over the last 30 years, the Hispanic population has grown dramatically; today, 9.2 percent of North Carolinians are Hispanic, with a median age of only 24 years; and

WHEREAS, in North Carolina, this high percentage of young people indicates that the Hispanic community will continue to flourish, and reflects the national theme of this year's Hispanic Heritage Month: "Shaping the Bright Future of America"; and

WHEREAS, our Hispanic population is shaping the bright future of North Carolina in every aspect of our society and economy, including business, agriculture, the arts, academia, medicine, the hospitality industry, the public sector, and civil society; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina is proud of our diverse culture, and encourages residents to celebrate our Hispanic community by participating in the events held by organizations across our state to commemorate this special occasion;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 15 — October 15, 2017, as "HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all.
