A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States of America, the guardian of our liberties, embodies the principles of limited government in a republic dedicated to rule by law; and

WHEREAS, September 17, 2017, marks the two hundred and thirtieth anniversary of the framing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic celebrations which will be held in commemoration; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17-23 as Constitution Week; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina encourages citizens to reaffirm the ideals of the 1787 Framers of the Constitution, by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 17 – 23, 2017, as "CONSTITUTION WEEK" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
