## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, window film, a significant energy saving material manufactured primarily in the United States, provides a safer and more secure environment for home owners, public buildings, and retail establishments by screening out dangerous solar rays that can cause skin cancer and harmful glare; and

WHEREAS, window film has been proven to be one of the most cost-effective means of reducing our carbon footprint, positively impacting the economy on both local and national levels; and

WHEREAS, the window film industry's contribution to the economy deserves recognition; their product can help both consumers and businesses save money on their energy bills and reduce peak demand for electricity; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina citizens and business owners should be more aware of the many benefits of window film as a cost-effective means of saving energy and creating job opportunities, both of which are critical to the economic health of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the window film industry is committed to educating the public on the many uses and advantages of window film through their nonprofit trade association, the International Window Film Association (IWFA); and

WHEREAS, North Carolina recognizes the citizens who manufacture, distribute, and install window film, and acknowledges the IWFA's work in educating the public about the economic and environmental impact of window film;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2017, as "NATIONAL WINDOW FILM DAY" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
