A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated, develops leaders and promotes brotherhood and academic excellence; and

WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated, members founded and supported institutions, including the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) and its magazine *The Crisis*, National Urban League and National Association of Black Journalists; and

WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated, members serve in communities around the world providing service and advocacy that promote education, economic, political and social justice;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim March 19 – March 25, 2017, as "ALPHA PHI ALPHA FRATERNITY INCORPORATED, EMPOWERING OUR COMMUNITIES WEEK" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
