WHEREAS, led by Hall of Fame Coach Roy Williams, this team defeated the Gonzaga Bulldogs on April 3, 2017, winning the 6th National Collegiate Athletic Association Championship, 7th national title overall for the Carolina men's basketball program; and

WHEREAS, Coach Williams, having completed his 14th season with the University of North Carolina, is one of only six Division I men's basketball coaches to have won at least three national championships; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina is proud to congratulate and recognize the accomplishments of Coach Williams and this extraordinary team, wishing them continued success as student-athletes and throughout their future careers:
