A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, estuaries are unique places where freshwater from rivers and streams mixes with saltwater from the ocean; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina has the largest estuarine system of any single state on the Atlantic coast; and

WHEREAS, estuaries provide critical habitats for abundant marine life; and

WHEREAS, estuaries support important economic sectors, including tourism, and commercial and recreational fisheries; and

WHEREAS, fish from North Carolina estuaries and coastal rivers migrate throughout the Atlantic coast to support significant commercial fisheries along the Atlantic Seaboard; and

WHEREAS, estuaries support popular recreational activities and provide a place to swim, fish, boat, and bird watch; and

WHEREAS, estuaries provide educational opportunities for learning and research, as well as citizen participation and stewardship to help sustain them as a natural resource;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 15 – 22, 2018, as "ESTUARIES WEEK" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
