A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, proceeds from a life insurance policy can go a long way toward stabilizing a family's finances, relieving immediate expenses, meeting debts, and covering long term financial needs such as education and mortgages;

WHEREAS, planning ahead with life insurance can help to replace lost income and ensure the financial protection of family and loved ones; and

WHEREAS, Life Insurance Awareness Month serves as an opportunity to start thinking about life insurance protection and reminds people to review their beneficiaries to make sure they are up to date; and

WHEREAS, individuals who are eligible for life insurance can seek advice from qualified insurance professionals and take the actions necessary to achieve a financially secure future for their loved ones; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina commends the many dedicated professionals of the life insurance industry in our communities for their ongoing commitment to enhance financial and retirement security for the families of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim September, 2018, as "LIFE INSURANCE AWARENESS MONTH" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
