WHEREAS, forensic science plays a critical role in public outreach and crime prevention, and is evolving in its role as an important factor of the criminal justice community; and

WHEREAS, crime scene investigators, forensic examiners, and forensic scientists provide unbiased, accurate, and reliable analyses of evidence recovered at crime scenes across our state and nation; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina State Crime Laboratory, which operates a full-service laboratory in Raleigh, a Western Regional Crime Lab in Edneyville, and a Triad Regional Crime Lab in Greensboro, provides important forensic analysis resources to law enforcement agencies across our state; and

WHEREAS, numerous professional organizations have recognized September 20 - 26, 2020, as National Forensic Science Week, with individuals across our nation celebrating this incredibly important field of work; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina is proud to recognize the hard-working people that compose our forensic science organizations and their commitment to proper scientific investigations for the cause of justice;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 20 - 26, 2020, as "NATIONAL FORENSIC SCIENCE WEEK" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
