A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Children's Tumor Foundation has designated May 2019 as Neurofibromatosis (NF) Awareness Month to educate the public about this rare genetic disorder; and

WHEREAS, an estimated more than 2 million people worldwide are living with NF, and the disorder occurs in 1 in 3,000-4,000 individuals in the United States; however, NF remains relatively unknown to the public; and

WHEREAS, NF affects people of either gender and in all races and ethnic groups; and

WHEREAS, NF causes tumors to grow in the nervous system throughout the body and can affect development of the brain, cardiovascular system, bones, and skin; and

WHEREAS, NF can lead to blindness, deafness, bone abnormalities, disfigurement, learning disabilities, disabling pain, and cancer; and

WHEREAS, the Children's Tumor Foundation and other concerned organizations and individuals promote medical research aimed at finding effective treatments and, ultimately, a cure for NF;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim May, 2019, as "NEUROFIBROMATOSIS AWARENESS MONTH" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
