#### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, pecans are the only major tree nut native to North America; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina is one of the top 10 pecan producing states in the nation in production of new and improved varieties, and produces 3 to 5 million pounds of pecans annually with approximately 2,000 acres; and

WHEREAS, the largest concentration of commercial pecan orchards is located in Eastern and Southeastern North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, pecans are known not only for their delicious flavor, but also for their many health benefits; pecans are high in unsaturated fats and can be helpful in lowering cholesterol; and

WHEREAS, pecans contain more than 19 vitamins and minerals including folic acid, calcium, magnesium, phosphorus, potassium, zinc, and vitamins A, B, and E; and

WHEREAS, the versatility of pecans makes them a useful ingredient in a wide variety of foods, including baked goods, candies, and ice creams; and

WHEREAS, the pecan industry is yet another part of the total diversification of North Carolina's \$87 billion agriculture and agribusiness industry;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim November, 2018, as "**NORTH CAROLINA PECAN MONTH**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
