WHEREAS, the Lions of Judah play a vital role in creating social justice, aiding the vulnerable, preserving human dignity, and building Jewish identity; their dedication to the Jewish community sets an exemplary standard of leadership and giving; and

WHEREAS, the Jewish Federation of Raleigh-Cary works to build a strong Jewish future, and the lives of these 13 extraordinary women exemplify that mission; their stories of strength, resilience, love, caring, and commitment are inspiring to the entire community; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina recognizes the Lions of Judah of the Jewish Federation of Raleigh-Cary, and commends these 13 women for their contributions to our state;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim November 1, 2018, as a day "IN RECOGNITION OF 13 EXTRAORDINARY WOMEN" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
