## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, pulmonary fibrosis is a serious disease that creates scarring (fibrosis) in the delicate lung tissue of affected patients, causing progressive, incurable lung disease; and

WHEREAS, pulmonary fibrosis progresses quickly, often leading to a diminished quality of life, disability, and/or death within a few short years; and

WHEREAS, approximately 200,000 people in the United States are estimated to be affected by idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis (IPF), which is a type of pulmonary fibrosis with no identifiable cause; and

WHEREAS, because pulmonary fibrosis is often misdiagnosed and underdiagnosed, increased awareness is imperative to improve the rate of detection and immediate treatment; and

WHEREAS, the Pulmonary Fibrosis Foundation and other organizations work to unify patients, caregivers, medical professionals, and the public by providing and sharing the latest information about advancements as well as work still to be done within the global pulmonary fibrosis community; and

WHEREAS, Pulmonary Fibrosis Awareness Month is an opportunity to improve disease education, advocate research funding, and foster collaboration among those affected by pulmonary fibrosis, including those living with the disease, caregivers, the medical and research community, and the pharmaceutical industry;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim** September, 2018, as **"PULMONARY FIBROSIS AWARENESS MONTH"** in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
