WHEREAS, the center has provided residential, educational, early childhood intervention and respite care services to over 400 local families annually and is considered a pioneer and visionary leader that started by offering necessary resources, which has resulted in strengthening our communities and changing the disability landscape; and

WHEREAS, the Tammy Lynn Center has created an inclusive community of equal rights and access for children and adults with disabilities through unwavering commitment and advocacy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim July 2, 2019, as **“TAMMY LYNN CENTER 50th ANNIVERSARY”** in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
