A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the work done by women in the construction industry in North Carolina and throughout our nation has contributed to the progress and well-being of our communities; and

WHEREAS, the construction industry has been a driving force in fostering community development through renovation and beautification projects, and through the promotion of skilled trade careers; and

WHEREAS, according to the United States Bureau of Labor, as of 2015, women account for 9 percent of all workers within the construction industry; and

WHEREAS, while estimates suggest women in the United States earn on average 81.1 percent of men's earnings for full-time wage and salary work, women in the construction industry earn an average of 95.7 percent when compared to men; and

WHEREAS, these statistics demonstrate the opportunities open to women in the construction industry sector; however, it remains important to advocate for the employment and advancement of women as a minority group within construction employment; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina chapters of the National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC) have distinguished themselves as a voice for women in construction throughout our state; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina joins the North Carolina chapters of the NAWIC in celebrating Women in Construction Week, and commends women in construction for their many and ongoing contributions to the communities and people of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim March 3 – 9, 2019, as **“WOMEN IN CONSTRUCTION WEEK”** in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
