### **A PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS,** in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, ensuring that North Carolina's youth are protected from all vaccine-preventable diseases is even more important than ever before; and

**WHEREAS,** to bolster efforts to better protect our youth from the dangerous and often deadly disease meningitis, beginning August 1, all rising 12<sup>th</sup> graders in North Carolina will be required to have a second, booster dose of meningococcal conjugant vaccine; and

**WHEREAS,** the burden of vaccine-preventable disease in North Carolina affects adolescents of all cultures, races, ethnicities, and societal groups; and

WHEREAS, safe and effective vaccines are readily available to protect against disease, disability, and death from vaccine preventable diseases including tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough), hepatitis A, hepatitis B, human papillomavirus (HPV), influenza (Flu), measles, mumps, rubella, meningococcal disease, polio, and varicella (chickenpox); and

**WHEREAS,** the annual observance of Adolescent Immunization Awareness Month is intended to increase public knowledge, acceptance, and use of vaccines to protect children, preteens, and teens against serious, life-threatening diseases; and

**WHEREAS,** North Carolina residents and health care providers are encouraged to learn more about the threat, medical implications, and prevention of adolescent vaccine preventable diseases;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim July, 2020, as "**ADOLESCENT IMMUNIZATION AWARENESS MONTH**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
