A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Arthrogryposis Multiplex Congenita (AMC) is a disorder that causes joint contractures in newborns, meaning their joints are stiff, crooked and lack the normal range of motion; and

WHEREAS, AMC is a rare disorder, occurring in 1 out of every 3,000 live births, which develops prenatally and can be caused by an underlying condition or syndrome; and

WHEREAS, AMC is an umbrella diagnosis which encompasses many conditions and syndromes; of the more than 400 different types of AMC, Amyoplasia, Distal Escobar Syndrome is the most common; and

WHEREAS, AMC can affect joints in the hands, feet, hips, knees, elbows, shoulders, wrists, fingers and toes, as well as the jaw and spine; while all these joints can be affected, some may not be affected as no two people experience the same symptoms; and

WHEREAS, a newborn with multiple contractures that affect at least two different areas of the body may be diagnosed with AMC; and

WHEREAS, while there is no known cure for AMC, the condition is treatable; treatment goals aim to allow those living with the condition as much independence in their daily lives as possible; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina encourages people to increase awareness and understanding of AMC, and to support individuals and families in our communities who are affected by this disorder;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim June 30, 2019, as "ARTHROGRYPOSIS AWARENESS DAY" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
