### **A PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS, as North Carolina's energy industry becomes more dynamic with new technologies, older facilities will continue to be retired or upgraded in coming years; and

WHEREAS, the energy industry provides durable careers to thousands of residents serving our communities across North Carolina; as older workers retire, new energy professionals are needed to maintain a skilled and innovative workforce; and

WHEREAS, in a 2019 Clean Energy and Clean Transportation workforce assessment, the North Carolina Department of Commerce found that our state has a large clean economy workforce in a range of industries and occupations, and that North Carolina is meeting current clean economy workforce needs overall, in large part because of its strong workforce and education systems; and

WHEREAS, energy related professions include line workers, engineers, customer service representatives, project managers, site surveyors, power plant operators, electricians, power-line installers, construction laborers, operating engineers, team assemblers, HVAC mechanics and installers, plumbers, carpenters, among many others; each of these positions is valued and necessary; and

WHEREAS, through strategic partnerships, the Carolinas Energy Workforce Consortium strives to promote a unified effort to ensure residents of our state find rewarding careers in energy so that North Carolina can continue to grow and prosper;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 14 – 18, 2019, as "CAREERS IN ENERGY WEEK" in North Carolina, and commend its observance

to all citizens.
