**A PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, in 1925, the North Carolina General Assembly established the authority of the State Licensing Board for General Contractors for the purpose of safeguarding life, health, and property in protection of the public welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the general contracting industry in North Carolina, including residential and commercial building contractors, supported continuing education as a means of enhancing professional competence and professional responsibility for licensed general contractors further safeguarding life, health and property in protection of the public welfare; and

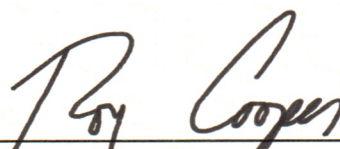
**WHEREAS**, in June 2019, the North Carolina General Assembly amended Article 1 of Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes by adding a new section to read: §87-10.2. Continuing Education, and on July 1, 2019, Governor Roy Cooper signed the amendment into law; and

**WHEREAS**, the North Carolina Licensing Board for General Contractors has been given the responsibility of establishing and administering the continuing education program pursuant to §87-10.2; and

**WHEREAS**, the North Carolina Licensing Board for General Contractors fulfilled its obligation under law and joins with residential and commercial general contractors in acknowledging the inaugural continuing education for general contractor courses scheduled for May 2020;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER**, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim May, 2020, as **“CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR GENERAL CONTRACTORS MONTH”** in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
