A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, North Carolina has set a statewide goal to increase postsecondary attainment to two million people with a degree or certificate by 2030; and

WHEREAS, ensuring more high school and college students complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is a critical step in reaching that goal; and

WHEREAS, the statewide goal for the percentage of high school seniors completing the FAFSA is 80% by 2030; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina is leaving an estimated \$89 million on the table in Pell Grants for students who did not submit a FAFSA; and

WHEREAS, submitting the FAFSA provides North Carolinians with opportunities to access critical financial aid resources to help them pay for college; and

WHEREAS, during the month of June, all North Carolina high school seniors and current college students are encouraged to join in the FAFSA FRENZY by submitting their FAFSA; and

WHEREAS, residents are encouraged to support North Carolina high school seniors and college students as they complete the necessary steps to access financial aid resources that will allow them to succeed in postsecondary education;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim June, 2020, as "FAFSA FRENZY MONTH" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
