**WHEREAS**, the State of North Carolina has proclaimed the month of July, 2019 as a time in which we recognize the importance of jury service to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of North Carolina encourages all North Carolinians to commend the efforts of the jurors who support and participate in this integral part of our justice system; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of North Carolina encourages all North Carolinians to support the court system and fulfill a most important civic responsibility shared by every member of our democracy;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim July, 2019, as "JUROR APPRECIATION MONTH" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
