WHEREAS, according to the National Auctioneers Association, professional auctioneers sell on average a quarter of a trillion dollars in goods and assets each year in the United States; and


WHEREAS, individuals, communities, organizations, and government use the competitive free enterprise system as an effective means to establish fair market value for goods and commodities; and
